
We offer a wide range of work based and distance learning courses at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels.



Recognised Prior Learning

- Overall, we can use qualifications and professional experience and award credits.
- We recognise other qualifications from a range of awarding bodies such ILM.

- There are two entry points each year, September and January

Employers and providers have been working together to develop T Levels, with support from Department for Education and the Institute for Apprenticeships and Technical Education (the Institute). Groups of employers have participated in T Level panels to define the skills and requirements for each T Level course.

The Institute for Apprenticeships and Technical Education (the institute) and the Department for Education (DfE) has awarded ILM and City & Guilds to be the delivery partner for new T Level technical qualifications (TQs) in Management and Administration, from September 2022.
