## Approval support update

The approval window for eligible providers who wish to apply for September 2022 delivery will open on Monday 28 February 2022. We are currently reviewing and revising our approval process ready for next year and will start to communicate the process later this year.

Existing providers, and providers eligible to apply for 2022 delivery will be invited to a webinar in January which will provide a comprehensive overview of the process, how to access the approval documentation and the support that will be available from our Quality team and Technical Qualification Associates (TQAs).

We will also set up an approval and quality assurance web page in the new year, where all documents and guidance will be available.
