



What is changing?

From 1 January the ILMA service will no longer use numerical marks on the results sheets for ILM Leadership and Management qualifications.

Learners will be provided a pass or referral and feedback against each criterion. This works well for the Coaching and Mentoring qualifications where the use of marks was removed when the qualifications were refreshed.

Why this change?

We received customer feedback that the marks can cause disagreements between learners which we hope this improvement will mitigate. On the ILMA portal you will see '1' for referrals and '99' for passes in the marks field. We will look to remove this field from the portal in the future.


