Big thank you to employers for senior leader apprenticeship revision

I am delighted to report that the revision of the apprenticeship standard is now complete.

The Secretary of State for Education requested the review back in February 2020 and we have been updating on developments through a series of blogs.

The knowledge, skills and behaviours (KSBs) apprentices must learn as part of the apprenticeship standard and end-point assessment have been brought right up to date and the apprenticeship continues to align to Institute of Leadership and Management (ILM) and Chartered Management Institute (CMI) professional recognition.

Delivery of the apprenticeship has been made more flexible with the removal of the Masters qualification as a mandated part of the apprenticeshipalthough an employer would still be free to use such a qualification to deliver the apprenticeship, so long as it aligns to the KSBs. Apart from registration and certification costs, these would still be fundable under the levy up to the funding band limit.

Apprenticeship Funding Rules: 2021/22

Publication of the Apprenticeship Funding rules for 2021-22 delayed – expected by beginning of July

- Expect changes in the rules to what is and isn't eligible for funding from the levy, as ESFA carrying out review of eligible and ineligible costs.
- IfATE apprenticeship funding band model review outcome held back due to waiting for the ESFA eligible costs review (point above).



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
