- There is no mandated requirement to achieve a Master's degree or any qualification.
- The professional discussion remains and is informed by the portfolio
- The portfolio should not include any methods of selfassessment
- The strategic business proposal, presentation and questioning must be completed post-gateway
- The strategic business proposal must be 4000 words
- The apprentice must submit a brief summary (of no more than 500 words) outlining the details of the strategic business proposal to the EPAO for approval
- · The merit grade has been removed
- Fail, Pass and Distinction will be awarded for each assessment method as well as an overall outcome
- Assessment decisions will be made against the assigned grading criteria against each assessment method
