



Diploma in School Business Management

Who is this qualification for?

The Level 6 Diploma in School Business Management is designed for senior members of non-teaching staff working across small groups of schools or a single large school. These School Business Managers (SBMs) will have highlevel responsibility for managing human resources, finances and facilities. The qualification develops their knowledge and skills, enabling them to work more strategically and enhance their contribution in complex settings.

- Expand your skills, knowledge and competences to play a lead role in the management of schools
- Enhance your contribution to the leadership and management of your school
- Extend your knowledge and understanding of teaching and learning in schools and the management of resources for learning
- Improve your research skills to understand the school as an organisation
